

EYF supports talented and hard-working youths who aspire to have an aviation career but cannot afford the required financial responsibilities.

EYF provides scholarships, special training sessions and skill acquisition programmes.

BREAKDOWN OF THE PROJECT

- a. Project Title: Face of Eastwing Aviation
- b. Project Theme: Growing Dreams: Touching Lives Through Human Development
- c. Project Type: Academic Excellence Competition and Award ceremony

d. Project Overview

A two-day event aimed at unveiling the opportunities offered by the Eastwing Youth Foundation. The first day features the final selection of the top ten students who will participate in the pageantry and award ceremony slated for day two.

The event will be preceded by an intense sensitisation campaign to attract potential sponsors and partners, on the one hand, and guardians and youths, on the other hand.

e. **Project Targets**: Senior secondary school students, applicants seeking admission into tertiary institutions and first-year students of tertiary institutions. They will be tested on science and basic life skills associated with hospitality. Their emotional and social intelligence will also be tested. The preliminaries will run in local schools and culminate in the grand finale for the selection of 10 finalists, and the pageantry and award ceremony that will recognise them as the Best Ten Students in the South East States.

f. Added value

Aside from the pomp, the project is built on a foundation of mentorship by people of high calibre in society. This is calculated to enshrine in society a value system that incentivises youths to be hardworking.

The awards section will also recognise deserving citizens and institutions with awards such as 'Influential Aviation Person South East' and 'Best Science School South East,' amongst others.

g. Anticipated development

It is envisaged that the success of this project will encourage partnerships between EYF and airlines such as Air Peace, United Nigeria, Ibom Air etc, and offer EYF alumni opportunities for industrial training in the aviation sector.

h. Project Date: 16-17th April 2025

i. Project objectives:

1. Conduct educational workshops and distribute informative materials to educate schools in South-Eastern States, targeting more than 5,000 youths. There will also be training on soft skill

- on aviation e.g customer care, hospitality management etc.
- 2. Give Certificate of Participation to all participants in the grand finale of the event.
- 3. Give the ten best students an award of merit and scholarship to complete a course at the Eastwing Aviation Institute.
- 4. Offer scholarships, internship placement with partner airlines and all-expense paid vacation outside the country for Best Student who will be crowned the Face of Eastwing.
- 5. Present award plaques to deserving schools, hotels and influential aviation personnel and Certificate of Participation to the resource persons & volunteer judges.
- 6. Engage school administrators, community leaders, parents and guardians in interactive sessions and activities to abrogate and disabuse their minds about myths and apathy towards aviation careers.
- 7. Establish partnerships with other institutes (especially secondary schools), NGOs, and community leaders to ensure the sustainability of the project.
- 8. Officially unveil the winner of Face of Eastwing through a media tour; mount billboards of Face of Eastwing, and sponsor brands in strategic locations
- 9. The top ten winners of the Face of Eastwing Aviation competition will embark on an exclusive

tour of Enugu State's premier tourism sites."

Note: The scholarship is only for the overall winner. And the scholarship for the winner as well as the trip abroad depends on the sponsorship gotten.
